	II.1.1.	The animals have not shown signs of occurrence of American foulbrood, <i>Aethina tumida</i> (Small hive beetle) and <i>Tropilaelaps</i> spp. during the visual examination carried out within the last 48 hours prior to the time of departure of the consignment.

Their packaging and any accompanying feed or other material have not shown signs of presence of American foulbrood, <i>Aethina tumida</i> (Small hive beetle) and <i>Tropilaelaps</i> spp. during the visual examination carried out within the last 48 hours prior to the time of departure of the consignment.	
	II.2.	According to official information, the animals meet the following animal health requirements:	
	II.2.1.	The animals come from an apiary situated in the centre of a circle of at least three km radius where American foulbrood has not been reported during the last 30 days prior to the date of departure of the consignment and which is not restricted due to an outbreak of American foulbrood.	
	II.2.2.	The animals come from an apiary situated in the centre of a circle of at least 100 km radius, where infestation with <i>Aethina tumida</i> (Small hive beetle) and <i>Tropilaelaps</i> spp. has not been reported and which is not restricted due to a suspected case or the confirmed occurrence of infestation with <i>Aethina tumida</i> (Small hive beetle) or <i>Tropilaelaps</i> spp.
